TREATMENTS - Cognitive Remediation

Neuropsychology is the study of brain-behaviour relationships, and has traditionally utilised the classical lesion-based approach – relating focal brain damage to patterns of preserved and impaired cognitive functioning. In the majority of psychiatric disorders, however, focal brain lesions are rare, and the real challenge of neuropsychology in relation to psychiatry is to understand abnormal behaviour in terms of dysfunctional processing of information.
