Literal vs. Figurative

Language Literal language means exactly what it says, while figurative language uses similes, metaphors, hyperbole, and personification to describe something often through comparison with something different. See the examples below. **Literal Descriptions** Grass looks green. Sand feels rough. The flower smells sweet.

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Alliteration: Repeated consonant sounds at the beginning of several words in a phrase (Robbie saw rabbits resting by roses.) Hyperbole: An exaggeration (That building can touch the clouds.)
