Do this in less than a page. Capture the essential ideas and perhaps one or two key examples. This approach offers a great way to be sure that you know what the reading really says or is about. Write your own exam question based on the reading. Teach what you have learned to someone else!

Active Listening Skills, Examples and Exercises

Pay attention: As we mentioned, being attentive is a key component of active listening. Besides avoiding distracting thoughts and external triggers (such as side conversations, phone notifications, etc), you should also show that you're paying attention through your body language and verbal confirmations.; Ask open-ended questions: Open-ended questions cannot be answered with a simple yes or no.
