Adding Subtracting Decimals
To add decimals, follow these steps: Write down the numbers, one under the other, with the decimal points lined up. Put in zeros so the numbers have the same length (see below for why that is OK). Then add using column addition, remembering to put the decimal point in the answer.

Lining up the decimal point when doing vertical addition or subtraction makes the calculation much easier. Adding zeros to the right of the decimal numbers may also be needed. When adding with decimals and whole numbers students may also have to add a decimal point on the right of the whole number.
