Use the Guided Reading Reader Characteristic Anecdotal Notes Form while completing running records with your students or as you are assessing students' reading during Guided Reading. Assess reader characteristics in 5 areas, including text operations, decoding skills, self-correcting skills, fluency, comprehension, and affect.
