When dealing with anthropometric measurements of the head, the patterns of these measures are referenced according to the ABNT NBR 15127 and DIN 33402. These are: a-Circumference (horizontal perimeter of the head), b-width (distance greater front head), c-length (greatest distance from the profile of the head) and cephalic index.
