Anticipation guides consist of statements about themes from a text and ask students to evaluate their own thoughts about those themes. Anticipation guides help students build background when they think about ideas before they engage in a text. The guide also helps students to identify and connect themes as they read the text.

Anticipation Guide. To use an Anticipation Guide the teacher writes four or five statements about what may happen in the story the students will be reading. Prior to the statement is an Agree and Disagree box.

Animal Farm Anticipation Guide

To help students understand point of view (POV), you can use an anticipation guide where students write down how they feel about the statements. Then, after they read the story, they write down how a specific character feels about the same statements.
