Create a 95% confidence interval for the mean SAT-I Math score at this high school: Assumptions:

- Randomization—this condition is met because all students have an equal chance of being drawn.
- 10% condition—the SAT Math scores I observed are fewer than all students' scores in the high school.
- Nearly Normal Condition—the histogram of the speeds is unimodal and symmetric.
