This can usually be found on the cover or title page. To list an author, write the last name, a comma, and the first and middle initials, followed by a period. Example: McGraw, S. Next, identify when this book was written. In this case, you will need to open the book and look inside, usually on the back of the title page, to find the date, 2015.

All information in these lines should be: Double spaced; Centered; Use both upper and lower case text; Use the same easy-to-read serif font either specified by the institution or the APA recommended Times New Roman in 12 point.

APA Title Page (Cover Page) | Guidelines, Example, Template

The title page (also known as the cover page) is the front page of your paper. It should contain the title of the paper, your name, and the institution for which you writing. These details should be aligned in the middle of the page. The running head should be in the top-left corner of the page in uppercase, prepended only on the front page with "Running head:".

The APA manual 7th edition states that you should write your paper in an active voice and use the first person if you are discussing your

research. Thus, you should say “ With this investigation, I/we concluded that...” You should also use words like “suggests” or “indicates,” and be concise when writing your work.

APA Style

Your APA format title page should include 5 elements: running head, your paper's title, your name, your University and author note (if required by your professor). Elements Running head: Place the running head in your page's header: – use label “Running head:” then your shortened title (IN UPPERCASE LETTERS), align left
