If you want to grow an apple tree from seed, you have to be aware of some facts.

First of all, apple trees grown from seeds (and will not get grafted in the future) will most likely not produce fruits for the first 7-10 years of their life.

Some of them may not produce fruits for the whole of their lifetime.

The best exposure for apples is a north- or east-facing slope. Tree spacing is influenced by the rootstock, soil fertility, and pruning. Seedlings or full-size trees should be planted about 15 to 18 feet apart in a row. A dwarfing rootstock might be 4 to 8 feet apart in a row.

Apples grow best in full sun. An apple tree planted in partial sunlight will not bear as many fruits like an apple planted in full sun. Apples grow best in well-drained loamy soil, although they will grow in more sandy soil or in soil with some clay. Apples grow best in a neutral soil pH of 6.0 to 7.0.
