Standards for Treated Wood Since 1904 UC3B Above Ground, Exposed: Usually AWPA deck boards, rails, siding, joists, etc. UC4A Ground Contact, General Use: Soil, concrete, or fresh water contact items such as deck or fence posts, or some special heavy duty above ground applications like beams or girders.

AWPA's standards are the only standards for treated wood directly listed in the IRC and IBC, so the first thing to do is look for "AWPA" and the applicable standard, usually "U1" on the end tag. It's also important to look for the preservative code and retention (amount of preservative retained in the wood), for example, "ACQ-D" or "CA-C".

Types of Preservatives | Treated Wood

Wood treated to (UC4A) ground contact standards is ideal for general-use situations where the wood may contact moisture, the ground, or be installed in a manner that subjects the wood to comparable ground contact conditions – such as poor ventilation, tropical climates or frequent exposure to moisture.

The American Wood Protection Association (AWPA) has changed the U1 standards for treated wood used in residential, agricultural and commercial applications. The AWPA Book of Standards states, “ Standard U1 is the primary standard for specifiers, such as architects and engineers, but also for end users and building code officials.
