On 30 October 1877, a lieutenant of eight years' seniority got an additional half-ring of 3 / 16 in, increased to 1 / 4 in in 1891, and in 1914 became the new rank of lieutenant commander. In 1919, the admiral's narrow stripe was reduced to 1 / 2 in, but as King George V had not approved the change, the Royal Family continued to wear the wider ring.

As of December 2019, there are 75 commissioned ships in the Royal Navy. Of the commissioned vessels, twenty-three are major surface combatants (six guided missile destroyers, thirteen frigates, two amphibious transport docks and two aircraft carriers), and ten are nuclear-powered submarines (four ballistic missile submarines and six fleet submarines).
