C ô te d'Or. South and east of Chablis is the famed Côte d'Or, where the most renowned wines of Burgundy are produced. Here east- and southeast-facing slopes gain maximum benefit from the sun and are protected from the wind by the Morvan hills to the west. The base of the soil is limestone mixed with marl, a pebbly mix of limestone and clay.

The Côte de Beaune, around Beaune in the south, produces a mix of white wine and red wine. The Route des Grands Crus (Route Nationale 74) runs along the foot of the ridge and is popular with tourists. Scientists have not yet conclusively determined what factors cause the few small parcels of land on the Côte d'Or to produce superlative wines.

C te d'Or Wine Information. Second, the southerly C te de Beaune, which while well known for its whites, actually grows both Chardonnay and red grapes. The land in the Cote is mostly limestone, which produces high quality wines. One of the most famous villages in the C te de Beaune is Pommard, known for its heavy, full-bodied reds.

Côte d'Or Wine. Cote d'Or Home to the most famous wines in Burgundy, the Cote d'Or is a narrow strip of land situated on a fault line, which giving it enormous geological diversity. All of Burgundy's Grands Crus (except for those in Chablis) are located here. The Cote de Nuits is the most northerly part of the Cote d'Or.
