NCLEX in Canada is fairly new and for that reason, information is scarce. Starting in January 5th, 2015, the NCLEX-RN replaces the CRNE as Canada's national examination for those applying to be a registered nurse. There are actually TWO applications you will need to submit (there may be more for international/foreign educated students).

The NCLEX-RN is a pass/fail examination, designed to determine if you have an entry-level knowledge of nursing. Any nurse planning to work in Canada must be deemed as qualified to practice as a Registered Nurse (RN) or Licensed/Registered Practical Nurse (LPN/RPN). To qualify, an applicant must register with either the Canadian Nurses Association (CAN) or the Canadian Council for Practical Nurse Regulators (CCPNR).

Applying for an RN License with the Streamlined Process. To qualify for NYSED's Streamlined Process, you must have a BN, BSN, or BScN degree that was granted after January 1, 2015 by a university located in a Canadian province (except Quebec).. Your BN, BSN, or BScN degree program must be recognized by a Canadian province (other than Quebec) as qualifying you to practice as an RN in the province.
