In 1576 the family moved to Caravaggio (Caravaggius) to escape a plague that ravaged Milan, and Caravaggio's father and grandfather both died there on ...

Caravaggio, Calling of St. Matthew – Smarthistory Baglione's best known painting, Sacred Love and Profane Love (or The Divine Eros Defeats the Earthly Eros and other variants), was a direct response to Caravaggio's Amor Vincit Omnia (1601 – 02). Baglione's painting exists in two versions, the earlier in the Gem à Idegalerie, Berlin (c. 1602 – 03) and the later in the Galleria Nazionale d'Arte Antica at Palazzo Barberini in Rome.
