An anterior discectomy and fusion (ACDF) is the most commonly used method for most cervical herniated discs. During the surgery, the disc is removed through a small incision in the front of the neck. The cervical spine can either be approached from the front (anterior approach) or from the back (posterior approach). In general, where possible, most surgeons favor an anterior approach for most conditions.

Diagnosis and prognosis. The physical examination of this patient revealed that the origin of the patient's symptoms was most likely the cervical spine and not the left shoulder.
