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### CHAPTER 15: THE CLAUSE Clauses

Subordinate Clauses A subordinate (or dependent) clause does not express a complete thought and cannot stand by itself as a sentence. Although every clause contains a subject and a verb, not every clause expresses a complete thought. Generally, clauses that begin with when, whom, because, that, if, or until do not express complete thoughts.

### CHAPTER 15: THE CLAUSE Identifying Clauses

The Subordinate Clause A subordinate (or dependent) clause does not express a complete thought and cannot stand by itself as a complete sentence. A subordinate clause must be joined with at least one independent clause to make a sentence and express a complete thought. EXAMPLES Since I was curious about acupuncture, I looked it up in an encyclopedia.

The meaning of a subordinate clause is complete only when the clause is attached to an independent clause. EXAMPLE If wishes were horses, then beggars would ride. Sometimes the word that begins the subordinate clause is the subject of the clause. EXAMPLE This is a line that comes from a Mother Goose rhyme.

Chapter 7: Subordinate Clauses Clauses, as we have seen, can be coordinated with each other the sentence consists of a set of conjuncts. A clause can also serve other grammatical functions another clause: A clause which serves a grammatical function (other than conjunct) inside another clause is called a subordinate clause.
