It is likely that the text has an earlier, possibly Lutheran, origin. In the 1753 hymnal it is placed not in the chapter containing “Old Moravian hymns” nor with the “18th-century Moravian hymns” but rather with “evangelical hymns from the 17th century” (“evangelische Lieder im siebzehnden Seculo”).
