If you pull up the shroud at the back of the hand brake lever you will see the adjustment screw. Pull the lever up to two or three clicks and begin to tighten the screw (10mm deep socket is best). Have a mate check the rear wheels and when they cannot be moved, release the brake lever and check if the wheels are free.
