Here is how the degree of operating leverage looks if fixed costs were only \$500: Degree of operating leverage = \$3,000 ÷ (\$3,000 - \$500) Degree of operating leverage = \$3,000 ÷ \$2,500. Degree of operating leverage = 1.2. The ratio went down from 1.5 to 1.2. Now contribution margin (\$3,000) is 1.2 times profit (\$2,500).
