Critical care is full of potential stressors. A review by Walder et al.[1] found that up to 71% of critically-ill patients experience agitation, confusion, and anxiety during their ICU stay. Common stressors include pain, sleeplessness, mechanical ventilation, tubes in the nose and mouth, genitourinary catheters, noise, hallucinations, discomfort due to medical procedures, thoughts of death ...
