In the AHA paper published in 2012, the prescribed rate of compression was at least 100 compressions per minute. However, in the updated 2015 version of the CPR guideline, a compression rate of 100-120 per minute is now recommended.

Veterinary CPR guidelines by experts, for everyone. Less than 6% of dogs and cats that experience cardiopulmonary arrest (CPA) survive to hospital discharge, while the survival rate in people is over 20%. Until the advent of evidence-based guidelines and standardized training in human medicine, survival rates in people were similar to animals.

BLS Simplified Algorithm

Research: Inform and support scientific research to improve our approach to CPR in animals. Through the efforts of over 100 veterinary specialists working with the RECOVER initiative, the very first evidence-based veterinary CPR guidelines were published in the Journal of Veterinary Emergency and Critical Care in 2012.

2015 - 2020 BLS Guideline Changes

CPR involves chest compressions for adults between 5 cm (2.0 in) and 6 cm (2.4 in) deep and at a rate of at least 100 to 120 per minute.

The 2015 guidelines still recommend traditional CPR cycles of 30 chest compressions to two rescue breaths for one-rescuer CPR in all age groups and for two-rescuer CPR in adults. The 15:2 ratio of compressions to breaths remains in the 2015 guidelines for two-rescuer CPR for children and infants.
