Instead of combining the trumpet and cornet classes, Auber decided to keep the classes separate. He named Arban the professor of the new cornet class and a former classmate of Arban's, Jules Cercilier, as the new professor of the trumpet class, replacing their former teacher Dauverne, who had already decided to retire later that year.
