Riemann knew that the non-trivial zeros of the zeta function were symmetrically distributed about the line  $s = 1/2 + it$ , and he knew that all of its non-trivial zeros must lie in the range  $0 < \text{Re}(s) < 1$ . He checked that a few of the zeros lay on the critical line with real part  $1/2$  and suggested that they all do; this is the Riemann hypothesis.
