Applying a continental lens, over three-quarters (77.6%) of Hong Kong's exports by value were delivered to fellow Asian countries while 10.8% were sold to importers in Europe. This rule requires exporters (the USPII) and re-exporters using a BIS license or a license exception, such as license exception ENC, to export or re-export to Hong Kong items controlled for NS, MT, NP column 1, or CB reasons to first obtain certain documents that verify the items' status under the Hong Kong Import and Export (Strategic Commodities) Regulations.

Hong Kong's Top Trading Partners 2019 - World's Top Exports

Certain deemed exports and deemed re-exports are also authorized under existing license exceptions until August 28, 2020. This rule did not change the Export Administration Regulations' (EAR) Country Chart, which means that all items that could be exported, re-exported, or transferred to Hong Kong without a license or the use of a license exception may still be shipped.

Trade and Industry Department: Publications

In 2014, Hong Kong imported ~24,600 MTs of cigarettes and exported ~29,900 MTs, equating to a 121% re-export rate. This figure is consistent with the 2010 to 2014 average when 122% of all imports were re-exported. A re-export rate above 100% implies that Hong Kong is manufacturing cigarettes domestically and re-exporting them alongside imports.

Hong Kong – Re-exports of US-origin electronics, computers ...

The top three origins of Hong Kong's re-exports in 2019 were the Mainland, Taiwan and Korea. The values of re-exports originated from them were HK\$2,154.7 billion, HK\$415.1 billion and HK\$251.1 billion respectively. Their corresponding shares of the total re-exports values in the year were 54.7%, 10.5% and 6.4%.
