The European Union approved the General Food Law Regulation in 2002 (Regulation (EC) No 178/2002), which created new laws on safety, traceability, withdrawal and recall requirements. In order for the UK to enforce this new regulation, the General Food Regulation 2004 was enacted, which even changed the definition of food as originally presented in the Food Safety Act 1990.

Other than ensuring a coherent approach, it also provides the general framework for those areas not covered by specific harmonised rules but where the functioning of the internal market is ensured by mutual recognition.
