Examples of containers are collections of short stories or poems, a television series, or even a website. A container is anything that is a part of a larger body of works.

General Format // Purdue Writing Lab

Tell the audience your source before you use the information (the opposite of in-text citations). Do not say, " quote, unquote " when you offer a direct quotation. Use brief pauses instead. Provide enough information about each source so that your audience could, with a little effort, find them.

How to Cite Different Source Types. In-text citation doesn ' t vary depending on source type, unless the author is unknown. Reference list citations are highly variable depending on the source. How to Cite a Book (Title, not chapter) in APA Format. Book referencing is the most basic style; it matches the template above, minus the URL section.

Citing Web Pages In Text. Your in-text citation should lead your reader to the corresponding entry in the reference list. For sources with no date use n.d. (for no date) in place of the year: (Smith, n.d.). Below are examples of using in-text citation with web pages.

The way you cite a source depends on the citation style. Many citation styles use in-text citations in parentheses directly after the quote, while others require you to use footnotes. Put all the citation information at the end of the sentence: Include some of the citation information as part of the sentence: Each source cited in-text must also be listed in your References list. However, there are two exceptions to this rule: Personal communications (e.g., interviews, emails, or classroom discussion posts)

In-text citations for print sources with known author. Human beings have been described as "symbol-using animals" (Burke 3). These examples must correspond to an entry that begins with Burke, which will be the first thing that appears on the left-hand margin of an entry in the Works Cited: Burke, Kenneth.

Citing the comments left on social media or a website begins with the commenter's name or username. To indicate that you are citing a comment, follow the name with a period and then the words Comment on, followed by the title of the source (for example, the name of the article) in quotation marks. This is then followed by the title of the website in italics, and the publisher, if applicable.
