For example, provocation that would cause a reasonable person to act in a heat of passion—a state of mind where one acts without reflection—may result in a reduction of a charge of murder to a charge of voluntary Manslaughter .

In closing decades, in widely upheld form, it amounted to proving a reasonable total loss of control as a response to another's objectively provocative conduct sufficient to convert what would otherwise have been murder into manslaughter.

Provocation, or as it is now known "extreme provocation", operates to reduce a charge of murder to manslaughter: s 23(1) Crimes Act 1900. Although provocation is often described as a "partial defence", where the evidence raises the issue, the prosecution must prove beyond reasonable doubt that the killing was not in response to extreme provocation: s 23(7) Crimes Act (previously s 23(4 ...
