1800cc Stroker/Big Bore Kits - The 1800cc 124/131 twin cam engines can be enlarged to about 2100cc by using the two liter crank and 2mm larger diameter pistons. This requires minor machining of the 1800cc block for connecting rod clearance. PBS can supply the required parts for this conversion.
