On November 7, 2014, Centers for Medicaid & Medicare Services (CMS) provided guidance, in the form of state health official letter (SHO #14-002 (PDF, 165.89 KB)), on the considerations that the Secretary of Health and Human Services (HHS) intends to apply in exercising her authority under section 5000A(f)(1)(E) of the Code to recognize certain types of Medicaid coverage as minimum essential coverage (MEC).

Prior to 2014, Florida offered numerous Medicaid waivers to seniors to help them pay for long-term care. However, Florida no longer offers such waivers, and requires all Medicaid recipients to enroll in a Managed Long-Term Care (MLTC) program to receive coverage for nursing homes, assisted living facilities, and in-home care.
