When to Use TIFF . TIFF (Tagged Image File Format) is suitable for any type of bitmap (pixel-based) images destined for print because this format uses that industry's CMYK color standard. TIFF produces large files, thanks to a common resolution of 300 ppi with no quality loss. TIFF also preserves layers, alpha transparency, and other special features when saved from Photoshop.

GIF File Format. GIF (Graphics Interchange Format) is a bitmap image format which works well for saving any type of grayscale or 256 color image. The color limitation makes the GIF format unsuitable for reproducing color photographs and other images with continuous color, but it is well-suited for simpler images such as graphics or logos with solid areas of color.
