Leveled books are used in guided reading, or leveled reading, small-group instruction. This approach recognizes that a wide range of reading ability exists within any grade level or age group. Students are placed in similar-ability groups and given developmentally appropriate books to read.

Reading Levels A-D (Kindergarten) Level A books tell very simple stories. They feature one short line of text, with a predictable pattern that repeats on each page. The text focuses on a few simple sight words such as "the," "is," or "a."

About Leveled Texts, the Text Level Gradient and Guided ...

Guided reading is used in the classroom for small-group instruction. When your child enters a new grade, he or she is assessed and assigned a guided reading level based on word knowledge, comprehension, and fluency. The levels range alphabetically from A to Z, with level A representing the lowest level and level Z the highest.

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
