The Cold War: Causes, Major Events, and How it Ended - History

As nearly all the colonial states achieved independence in the period 1945–1960, they became Third World battlefields in the Cold War. India, Indonesia, and Yugoslavia took the lead in promoting neutrality with the Non-Aligned Movement, but it never had much power in its own right. The Soviet Union and the United States never engaged directly in full-scale armed combat.

Meeting in April 1945, just days after Franklin D. Roosevelt's death and Truman's succession to the presidency, delegates drafted the organization's founding charter, which closely resembled the charter of the failed League of Nations after World War I. Because World War II had proved that the United States could no longer remain isolated from world affairs, the new charter passed easily through the Senate ratification process that summer.
