How to Write a Critique: The Author's Role We suggest that the author try not to talk at all during an oral critique except to ask clarifying questions at the end (if the author didn't hear or understand something, he or she can ask the critiquer to repeat or expand on it).

Writing a critique on a work helps us to develop: A knowledge of the work's subject area or related works. An understanding of the work's purpose, intended audience, development of argument, structure of evidence or creative style. A recognition of the strengths and weaknesses of the work.

A critique, therefore, is a reader's personal reaction (positive or negative) or an evaluation of what an author has to say. The writer of a critique has a responsibility to explain how they reached their critical conclusions about the piece.

We all respond to negative feedback better if there's some positive, too, and it sets a more helpful tone for the critique. Overly critical readers sometimes need to be reminded that pieces of writing have something going for them.

Part of writing a successful argument is anticipating counter-arguments and addressing them head-on. In your critique, look for any counter-arguments the original author missed. Are they enough to derail the author's point?

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
