A general rule is to pick the first note (with your thumb) with the root note for each chord. So for a C-chord, the thumb picks the C-note (3rd fret/5th string) and then the E-note (second fret/4th string); sometimes the thumb alternates with the G-note (3rd note/6th string).

Do exactly what we said in the basic pattern, but after you hit the sixth string with your third finger, reverse direction, once more picking the fifth string with your second finger and then the fourth string with your forefinger.
