Below are some basic guidelines for formatting a paper in MLA Style: General Guidelines. Type your paper on a computer and print it out on standard, white 8.5 x 11-inch paper. Double-space the text of your paper and use a legible font (e.g. Times New Roman).

When writing your paper or thesis, you will often use these heading levels: Heading 1: Use heading 1 for the main elements of your paper, such as the "methods," "results," "conclusion" and "discussion" sections. Heading 2: Use heading 2 for the subsections underneath heading 1. For example, under "methods," include sections describing the "participant selection," "experiment design" and "procedure."

Heading Papers

Levels of Heading There are five levels of heading in APA Style. Level 1 is the highest or main level of heading, Level 2 is a subheading of Level 1, Level 3 is a subheading of Level 2, and so on through Levels 4 and 5. The number of headings to use in a paper depends on the length and complexity of the work.

Formatting APA Headings and Subheadings

The heading for your works cited pages should be the same as the heading for your inner pages, which include your name and the page number at the top. Enter the title as "Works Cited" and place this title 1-inch from the top of the page, see more details in the example illustration picture below.

Place your heading in the upper left-hand corner of the page. To make sure your typed paper is easy to read on a visual level, use a 12-point font and recognizable font style. While the Times New Roman font is often chosen, Arial, Modern, Lucina and Palermo are also acceptable because they are not script-style fonts.

However, in APA Style, the heading "Introduction" is not used, because what comes at the beginning of the paper is assumed to be the introduction. The first heading comes at Level 1. In this paper, the first heading is "Literature Overview," so it goes at Level 1.

Usually, short papers or articles use two to three levels, but longer papers necessitate up to five levels. A third-level heading exists inside a second-level heading section. Third-level headings are tabbed

once from the left margin, in bold font, and in sentence case for capitalization. This means on the first word and any proper nouns will be capitalized. This level of heading is unique in that a period should be placed after it.

How do I style headings and subheadings in a research paper?

Title of Paper Begin your paper with the paper title at the top of the first page of text. The paper title acts as a de facto Level 1 heading: It is centered and in bold title case font. Do not use the heading "Introduction"; text at the beginning of the paper is assumed to be the introduction. APA Style headings have five possible levels.

A heading level is a style of heading. Heading 1 is the largest (for major sections) while Heading 5 is the smallest (for the smallest sub-sections of papers). Unless you're writing a very long paper or dissertation, you will probably only ever use one or two Heading levels.

Headings, sections, subsections, or levels of subordination are a style of dividing your research paper into major parts, then minor subsections. Most college papers do not need headings, especially if you are only producing two to five pages.

Adding Headings to a Paper (Online) – PERRLA

The paper or chapter title is the first level of heading, and it must be the most prominent. Headings should be styled in descending order of prominence. After the first level, the other headings are subheadings—that is, they are subordinate. Font styling and size are used to signal prominence.
