Sheol/Hades once had two compartments: one for the souls of the saved, the other for the souls of the unsaved. This is clearly taught in Luke 16:19-31. The rich man died, his body was buried and he went to hell (Sheol/Hades)--see verses 22-23. In Sheol/Hades he was being tormented (tortured) by a flame (verses 23, 24, 25, 28).
