Begin point work using the direct-thumb technique. Place the ball of your thumb on the acupoint at a 90o angle to your horse's body. Apply about 1 to 2 pounds of pressure; when you feel resistance, let up on the point slightly and then apply pressure again. • Keep both hands on your horse.

Acupuncture and your horse. Most animals tolerate acupuncture well. Needles are inserted into acupuncture points based on examination and history. Electro-acupuncture, aqua-puncture, moxa or laser point stimulation may also be used. A treatment typically lasts ten to 30 minutes, depending on the animal's size, age and condition.
