The Instagram username can be seen with the post. But, for the individual's surname and initials or for the official name of a brand or organization, you'll need to consult the profile page (by clicking the profile image). Include the exact date of a post, as shown in the examples above.

If you cite from different volumes of a multivolume work, always include the volume number followed by a colon. Put a space after the colon, then provide the page number(s). (If you only cite from one volume, provide only the page number in parentheses.)

Usage notes. To include a reference to the source of quoted material which is contained within a `<blockquote>` or `<q>` element, use the `cite` attribute on the element. Typically, browsers style the contents of a `<cite>` element in italics by default. To avoid this, apply the `font-style` property to the `<cite>` element.

Possible complications: Some online services allow users to change their username. Some services change the capitalization of usernames depending on the context. If you are conducting research on a product or service, you may reference a user manual or instructional guide in your paper. Whenever you reference a source in your work, cite it properly so your reader knows where you found your information.

Start a bibliographic citation with the author's last name and first initial. Write the last name of the person who made the social media post, followed by a comma. Then, write the initials for their first

name and their middle name, if applicable.

List the author or authoring organization. If the author is a person's name, the last name should appear first, followed by a comma and then the first name and middle initial (if applicable). List the year of publication in parentheses, followed by a period. Make sure the period falls outside the parentheses.

If you are going to cite a MATLAB user's guide, you need to cite the version you looked at. The MATLAB user's guides are available in a variety of formats. The easiest to cite would either be the hard copy (if you have it) or the online documentation (citing it as an electronic book).
