Use one space between the author's last name and the page number. Do not include any other punctuation inside the parentheses, and do not use the p. or pp. notation. Move the period from the end of the sentence, and place it after the closing parenthesis. This placement binds the citation to the quote.

your text, enclose the quotation within double quotation marks. Provide the author and specific page number (in the case of verse, provide line numbers) in the in-text citation, and include a complete reference on the Works Cited page.

Quotations with less than four lines will be in the regular text of your paper, with double quotations. Right after the last quotation mark include your in-text citation with author's last name and page number within parentheses. Example:

Write the quote within quotation marks. If you are quoting someone else, you must write it correctly word for word. Place the author's name at the end of the quote followed by a comma followed by the date and the page number of the publication -- surround all this with brackets.

When a source is not listed by author in the "Works Cited," you must cite it in the text by whatever element comes first instead. In the case of movies, that means the title, italicized. Because movies do not have page numbers, you only need the title, either in a single phrase or in parentheses following the quote.

Cite the source of your quote within the text of your paper. The American Psychological Association (APA) Style requires listing the author's name and the date the quote appeared in print. Use parentheses immediately following the quote, such as (Webster, 1979).

Enclose short quotations in double quotation marks. For quotes of fewer than 4 typed lines or 3 lines of a poem, type the information verbatim from your source text, putting double quotation marks around it. Include punctuation inside the quotation marks only if they are part of the source text.

Include an in-text citation when you refer to, summarize, paraphrase, or quote from another source. For every in-text citation in your paper, there must be a corresponding entry in your reference list. APA in-text citation style uses the author's last name and the year of publication, for example: (Field, 2005).

Short quotations If you are directly quoting from a work, you will need to include the author, year of publication, and page number for the reference (preceded by "p."). Introduce the quotation with a signal phrase that includes the author's last name followed by the date of publication in parentheses.

Place a basic in-text citation at the end of the referenced material. The format for this type of citation is, in parentheses: Author's last name, year of publication, page on which the citation is located. For example, "It is said that words alone have specific uses, not sentences (Barthes, 1977, 5)."

To cite a quote using APA, put parentheses with the citation directly after the quoted material. For a citation with one or more authors, include their last names, the year of publication, and page number preceded by a "p." If you're citing something but don't know the author, put the title of the publication and its date in parentheses.

Cite a long quotations in a block. As with APA formatting, using the Chicago Manual you need to place quotations longer than 4-5 lines in a free-standing block. Start the quote on a new line, indented 0.5 inches (1.3 cm) from the left margin. Include the page numbers of the quote in parentheses at the end of the quote.
