One end will have a hexagon shape—for a wrench to fit over—and the other end will be threaded to screw into your vehicle.

The oxygen sensor reading is used by the Engine Control Unit (ECU) to regulate the amount of air and fuel sent to the engine. Install a new oxygen sensor. Apply a small amount of anti-seize to the threads and hand-tighten the sensor in the exhaust. Using a torque wrench tighten the new oxygen sensor to 33 ft-lb. If you don't have a torque wrench use the ratchet to tighten the O2 sensor until it is on snug tight.

Locate the oxygen sensor underneath the hood or vehicle. Look for a part that looks like a spark plug with a thick, black cable coming out of it. The first sensor will always be next to the motor in the engine compartment.

The o2 sensor's voltage should fluctuate within the 100mV - 900mV (0.10V to 0.90V) range. If it is within this range, the o2 sensor is operating normally and you can stop testing. In case it is not within range, there is either an engine problem (loose hose) or the o2 sensor is bad.
