It is not commonly known that there are two different types of marshalling signals, ICAO (International Civil Aviation Organisation) and IATA (International Air Transport Association). Interestingly New Zealand CAA uses ICAO as their standard and the country's largest operator Air New Zealand uses IATA as their standard.

The ICAO list is not comprehensive, for example, it does not include hand signals to relay typical messages during de-icing and anti-icing operations. Commercial pilots operating from some military facilities may also be unfamiliar with some hand signals used in these places .

2.1 An operator is responsible for marshalling and parking of the operator's aircraft on an aerodrome. 2.2 An operator must ensure that any person designated for marshalling and parking duties uses the standard hand signals set out in Appendix I.

With left arm and wand extended at a 90° angle to the body, right hand makes the come ahead signal. The rate of signal motion indicates to the pilot the rate of aircraft movement desired. Turn Left (From the Pilots Point of View) With right arm and wand extended at a 90° angle to the body, left hand makes the come ahead signal.

If you are marshalling an aircraft and it is coming toward you and about to pass you by, DO NOT keep control of the aircraft by running backwards. After making sure there is another marshaller further down in a position to take over, signal to the pilot that you're passing control.
