A kakemono (掛け物, "hanging thing"), more commonly referred to as a kakejiku (掛け軸, "hung scroll"), is a Japanese hanging scroll used to display and exhibit paintings and calligraphy inscriptions and designs mounted usually with silk fabric edges on a flexible backing, so that it can be rolled for storage.. The "Maruhyōsō" style of kakejiku has four distinct named sections.
