The longest epic written is the ancient Indian Mahabharata, which consists of 100,000 ?lokas or over 200,000 verse lines (each shloka is a couplet), as well as long prose passages, so that at ~1.8 million words it is roughly twice the length of Shahnameh, four times the length of the Iliad and the Odyssey combined.

Genre: Epic Poetry. a long narrative poem. broad in scope (The Iliad takes place in the 9th year of the Trojan War) focuses on the exploits of the epic hero (in this case, Achilles) usually features mythological creatures, gods, and goddesses. a central theme which is closely related to the hero's journey.
