Court of Appeals

Created by the General Assembly in 1925, the Court of Appeals hears appeals in civil—or non-criminal—cases from trial courts and certain state boards and commissions. The court has 12 members who sit in panels of three. The panels meet monthly in Jackson, Knoxville and Nashville. When necessary, the court may meet in alternate locations.

In The Court Of Appeal

As the second-highest court in Indiana, the Court of Appeals hears appeals from the state's trial courts. The court does not preside over trials and must accept all appeals sent to it, with the exception of: Cases in which the death penalty or life-without-parole is rendered (appealed directly to the Indiana Supreme Court);

Courts of Appeal - DCA

The Court of Appeal comprises two divisions: the Civil Division, presided over by the master of the rolls, and the Criminal Division, headed by the lord chief justice. Both divisions hear appeals from the High Court and, through it, from lower courts and several other smaller tribunals.

2nd District Court of Appeal - 2DCA

If a case is tried in District or Circuit court, and the losing parties involved are not satisfied with the outcome, they may ask for a higher court to review the correctness of the trial court's decision.

The Michigan Court of Appeals is one of the highest volume intermediate appellate courts in the country. It was created by the 1963 Michigan Constitution and heard its first cases in January 1965. Generally, decisions from final orders of a circuit court or probate court, as well as some agency orders, may be appealed to the court as a matter of right.
