Specialties include inpatient, outpatient, emergency room, and physician evaluation and management coding. The main difference between coding outpatient and inpatient is the procedure codes. Current Procedural Terminology (CPT) codes are used for outpatient coding and the International Classification of Diseases Ninth Revision Clinical Modification (ICD-9-CM) is used for inpatient coding.

Difference Between Outpatient Coding and Inpatient Coding ...

The biggest difference between inpatient and outpatient medical coding remains the criteria and instructions for uncertain conditions. However, coders should always check the guidelines for additional instructions within the tabular and alphabetic indexes.

On the other hand, inpatient coding, which is reimbursed under Medicare Part A, is used to report diagnoses and services where the patient must stay at the facility long term in order to recover and/or receive further treatment. Like outpatient coding, it also uses ICD-10-CM to track diagnoses, but it employs ICD-10-PCS to report procedures.

inpatient coding & reimbursement: it's all about the Principal Diagnosis - be sure that you have the correct diagnosis code, and that it's coded 1st!
outpatient coding & reimbursement: it's usually about the S/Sx, because you must code up to the highest level of certainty for what you can support with

documentation - be sure that you have know whether or not there is an applicable diagnosis ...

Though the conventions and general guidelines apply to all settings, coding guidelines for outpatient and provider reporting of diagnoses will vary in a number of instances from those for inpatient diagnoses, recognizing that: The Uniform Hospital Discharge Data Set (UHDDS) definition of principal diagnosis does not apply to hospital-based outpatient services and provider-based office visits.
