SCORING THE PEDIATRIC SYMPTOM CHECKLIST-17 (PSC-17) • The PSC-17 is a shortened version of the PSC-35 and consists of 17 items. • Each item is rated as "NEVER," "SOMETIMES," or "OFTEN" present and scored 0, 1, and 2 respectively. • The total score is calculated by adding together the score for each of the 17 items.

Use the dosing syringe provided, or use a medicine dose-measuring device (not a kitchen spoon). Tamiflu may be taken with food if it upsets your stomach. To treat flu symptoms: Take Tamiflu every 12 hours for 5 days. To prevent flu symptoms: Take Tamiflu every 24 hours for 10 days or as prescribed. Follow your doctor's instructions.

Instructions for Children's Medication

Renal Impairment. CrCl less than 10 mL/minute: give 50% of the normal dose. Pediatric recommendations have included the following renal dose adjustments : CrCl 30 to 50 mL/minute: give 75% of the normal dose. CrCl 10 to 29 mL/minute: give 50% of the normal dose. CrCl less than 10 mL/minute: give 25% of the normal dose.
