Iso 32000 1
ISO 32000-1:2008 specifies a digital form for representing electronic documents to enable users to exchange and view electronic documents independent of the environment in which they were created or the environment in which they are viewed or printed.

ISO 32000-1 is the first ISO specification for PDF. The document is an ISO formalization of Adobe's own PDF Reference 1.7, and is technically identical to the Adobe document. On submission of PDF 1.7 to ISO for standardization in 2007, Adobe issued a summary of changes.

PDF Reference and Adobe Extensions to the PDF ...
A PDF compliant with the ISO 14289-1 (aka PDF/UA-1) specification is a constrained form of Adobe PDF 1.7 (as defined in ISO 32000-1) intended to ensure accessibility and support for assistive technology, such as screen readers. The UA acronym stands for Universal Accessibility; however, this phrase does not occur in ISO 14289-1.

In 2008, Adobe published a Public Patent License to ISO 32000-1 granting royalty-free rights for all patents owned by Adobe that are necessary to make, use, sell, and distribute PDF compliant implementations.

PDF 2.0, ISO 32000-2
As an alternative, Adobe will use the extensions mechanisms defined for ISO 32000-1 by which Adobe and other companies can identify extensions to the PDF specification. The new convention lets companies and other entities identify their own extensions relative to a base

ISO 32000-1 is the specification for the PDF format as a whole, in which context Tagged PDF appears as a single feature. This Guide is intended to provide information and examples to illuminate and clarify aspects of Section 14 of ISO 32000-1 for implementers of ISO 14289-1 (PDF/UA).

Technical Implementation Guide PDF/UA and ISO 32000-1

ISO published the approved ISO 32000-1 standard based upon PDF 1.7 in July 2008. ISO will also produce future versions of the PDF Specification. Since ISO 32000 is equivalent to Adobe's PDF 1.7, Adobe is not producing a PDF 1.8 Reference.

In ISO 32000-1, the text string type allowed character strings to be encoded in PDFDocEncoding or the UTF-16BE (big-endian) Unicode character encoding scheme. In ISO 32000-2, UTF-8 encoding is also permitted in this context.

PDF/A-3 allows for embedding of files of any type, but imposes requirements beyond those in "regular" PDF 1.7 files as defined by ISO 32000-1. Files that comply with these requirements are termed "associated" files; an explicit association must be made between each embedded files and the containing PDF or object or structure (e.g., image, page, or logical section) within the PDF.

For PDF files conforming to ISO 32000-1:2008 or earlier specifications (i.e. prior to ISO 32000-2:2017), the version number has the form 1.N, where N is a digit between 0 and 7. For example, PDF 1.6 is identified by %PDF-1.6 .

Part 2 of the PDF/A Standard is based on a PDF 1.7 (ISO 32000-1), rather than PDF 1.4 and offers a number of new features: JPEG 2000 image compression support for transparency effects and layers
