These guidelines provide an evidence-based approach and support best practice for the administration of intramuscular (IM) and subcutaneous (SC) injections. The goal of these guidelines is to facilitate the maximum therapeutic effects of medications while reducing complications, injury and discomfort for the child.

It is best if patients not enter the IV Preparation Room. The counter top for IV preparation is of a non-porous surface. It is wiped down with a new clean wet cloth or paper towels and dried thoroughly at the end of every workday.

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
