Cataract Surgery complications and problems after Cataract removal are generally pretty rare and are usually less than 5% in an otherwise healthy group of patients. In patients with additional eye diseases such as Glaucoma or Diabetic Retinopathy the complication rate may increase.

Severe cataract surgery complications resulting in blindness are very rare (less than 0.1%). Cataract surgery complications can occur during surgery itself, within a few days/weeks of surgery, or months after surgery. Often, these complications occur not because of anything you have or have not done.

Ocular surgery, whether cataract, cornea, glaucoma or retina has evolved to become highly efficient and predictable. However, complications can still occur, including corneal edema and decompensation, lens subluxation, vitreous loss, macular edema and retinal detachment.

Brown-McLean Syndrome (BMS) describes a condition in which the peripheral (2-3mm) inferior cornea become edematous and progresses circumferentially, sparing the central cornea in most cases.1-2 First described in 1969 as "peripheral corneal edema after cataract extraction," it was later renamed to Brown-McLean syndrome.3

When complications do occur, however, they may be classified into three categories by time of occurrence: intraoperative, early postoperative (first few days), or late postoperative (several weeks or months later).

Rarely, complications of cataract surgery may arise, including posterior capsular opacity or tears. Other complications include posterior vitreous detachment and toxic anterior segment syndrome. Most ophthalmologists agree that one of the most common complications of cataract surgery is something called posterior capsular opacity.

Cataract surgery successfully restores vision in the majority of people who have the procedure. People who've had cataract surgery may develop a secondary cataract. The medical term for this common complication is known as posterior capsule opacification (PCO). This happens when the back of the lens capsule — the part of the lens that wasn't removed during surgery and that now supports the lens implant — becomes cloudy and impairs your vision.
